As you may be aware, Ampleforth College has a system of Awards and Scholarships in recognition of academic ability or particular potential in Art, Design & Technology, Dance, Drama, Music, and Sport. In the Sixth Form, our Senior Scholarships offer a bespoke development programme to students with exceptional talents in one of these disciplines. This is the second year we are also offering JCB Senior Scholarships in Business or Engineering. These include work experience placements, internships, and JCB mentoring.

Tutors and Departments have made all Year 11 students aware of the Senior Scholarships available in the Sixth Form. If your daughter or son wishes to be considered, or is uncertain whether to apply, please encourage them to speak to their Tutor, relevant Head of Department, or Scholarship Mentor (for those with Basil Hume Scholarships). You may also wish to speak to one of these members of staff before completing an application form.

Applications can be made for more than one scholarship, but due to the commitment required of our scholars, it is not possible for a pupil to hold more than two awards; at Senior Scholarship level, it is unusual to hold more than one.

The deadline for Senior Scholarship applications is Friday 31 October 2025 with assessments held on Friday 7 November 2025. We will support your daughter/son in preparing for the scholarship - further details will be provided on receipt of an application.

Senior Scholarships are extremely prestigious and Senior Scholars are expected to demonstrate outstanding commitment, contribution, and leadership in their field of interest and make the most of the many opportunities on offer to further their talents. Each scholar is assigned a personal Scholarship Mentor who will work with them to develop a bespoke development programme and support their progress.
