Year 10 Careers Conversation Week, 11th – 15th May 2026

As part of the Careers provision at the college, all students in Year 10 have been allocated an individual Careers Guidance appointment with a qualified careers adviser during this week. Having quality, personalised guidance meetings is not only good practice, it allows students to explore all their options, ask questions and begin to take ownership of their career journey. Summary notes from the meeting will be recorded on the student's UNIFROG account.

Information about the Year 10 Careers Conversation Week was shared with parents earlier this year at the Year 10 Parents Day, and was shared with students during the activities on 13th March, the day of the Higher Education Conference and Careers Day. As part of the 13th March activities, the students have already begun researching career ideas using UNIFROG tools.

Your child will have their individual Careers Guidance meetings with either Mr Hall (Head of Careers) or a qualified adviser from CareerWave (www.careerwave.co.uk). This service is in addition to the standard Careers provision (such as the bookable short appointments with Mr Hall) and there is a cost to the school to provide this. We will not be asking parents to cover this cost, unless students fail to attend their appointment – **a contributory cost of £26 will be charged for missed appointments.**

Each appointment will last a full lesson. Students have been told their appointment times, and they will be reminded in advance of their appointments. It is important that students attend their appointment promptly.
