It is now time to write with some details relating to Results Day. A level and BTEC results will be published on **Thursday August 15**. Results will be accessible via MySchoolPortal in the same way as one would check for end of term grades or reports – except one needs to look under “Exam Results-Public”. **Results are issued to students at 08:00**.

We would strongly advise you to check your access to the MySchoolPortal before results day.
